ORDER

WHEREAS, in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, Chandrakanta Hazarika College, Milan Nagar, 'I' Lane, PO.- C.R. Building, Dist.-Dibrugarh, Assam-786003 (Code No. APE00388) has applied for grant of recognition for B.Ed. Course and hard copy received by Eastern Regional Committee of NCTE on 21.08.1997.

- 2. **AND WHEREAS**, on scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit submitted and the report received from VT and videography, and the certificates received from the affiliating body, the Committee is satisfied that the applicant fulfils the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the said teacher education programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, financial resources, etc., for running the programme.
- 3. AND WHEREAS, the institution was granted recognition to B.Ed. course vide order dated 13.03.2001 with an intake of 60 from the academic session 2001-2002 by ERC, NCTE.
- 4. AND WHEREAS, recognition to B.Ed. course was withdrawn under section 17(1) from the academic session 2011-2012 vide order dated 18.11.2010 and the appeal preferred by the institution against the withdrawal order was confirmed by the Appellate Authority vide order dated 26.04.2011.
- 5. **AND WHEREAS**, the ERC in its 242nd meeting held on 15th -16th July, 2017 considered the Order dated 02.06.2017 in W.P.(C) No. 2698 or 2011 filed by the institution in the Hon'ble Gauhati High Court and decided that re-inspection be conducted on payment of Rs. 1,50,000/- by the institution. On payment of requisite fee, inspection was conducted on 4th 5th September, 2017. The VT report was considered by ERC in 246th meeting held on 23rd -24th November, 2017 and accordingly, Letter of Intent u/c 7(13) issued on 02.01.2018 to the institution.
- 6. **AND WHEREAS**, the ERC in its 250th meeting held on 17th -18th February, 2018 considered the reply received from the institution in response to LOI and Show Cause Notice was issued on 23.02.2018. Thereafter, SCNs, as decided by ERC, issued time to time to the institution on 10.05.2018, 06.08.2018 and 11.09.2018 respectively.
- 7. **AND WHEREAS**, the ERC in its 267th Meeting held on 10th 11th February, 2019 considered the latest reply dated 07.02.2019 received from the institution and decided that formal recognition order under clause 7(16) of the NCTE Regulation 2014 for B.Ed, programme with an intake 100 (two basic units) with effect from the academic session 2019-2020 be issued to the institution.

Now original FDR after joint operation received from the institution on 28.02.2019.

In view of the above, the Committee decided as under:

In continuation of previously taken decision by ERC, formal recognition order under clause 7(16) of the NCTE Regulation 2014 for **B.Ed. programme** with an intake 100 (two basic units) with effect from the academic session 2019-2020 be issued to the institution.

- 9. NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act 1993, the Eastern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants recognition to Chandrakanta Hazarika College, Milan Nagar, 'I' Lane, PO.-C.R. Building, Dist.-Dibrugarh, Assam-786003 for conducting B.Ed. Course of two years duration with an intake 100 (two basic units) with effect from the academic session 2019-2020 under Clause 7(16) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014 subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:-
 - I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Loan raising against or mortgaging of FDRs shall not be done.
 - II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
 - III. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations 2014.
 - IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
- 10. Further, the recognition/permission is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University / Body, the State Government etc., as applicable.
- 11. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
- 12. The institution shall maintain its website with hyperlink to the Council and the Eastern Regional Committee, covering, inter-alia, the details of the institution, its location, name of the programme applied for with intake; availability of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms and other facilities or amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their proposed teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website, namely:
 - a) Sanctioned programmes along with annual intake in the institution;
 - b) Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph;
 - c) Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last quarter;
 - d) Names of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;

- e) Fee charged from students;
- f) Available infrastructural facilities;
- g) Facilities added during the last quarter;
- h) Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to, and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
- i) The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application;
- j) The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, If it so desires.
- k) Any false or incomplete information on its website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
- 13. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
- 14. The institution shall make available list of students admitted on its official website.
- 15. The Educational Institution shall follow Uniform Accounting System as brought out by ICAI and accepted by MHRD.
- 16. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made and issued there under, the institution will render itself liable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition / permission by the Regional Committee under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
